## PRECISION PANC SPRING UPDATE


The first three months of 2019 have continued to be very busy for the PRECISION-Panc project.

Since January 6 new sites have opened to the Master Protocol –Churchill Hospital, St George's, Southampton, St James', Queen Elizabeth Hospital Birmingham and King's College London.

We have recruited a total of 125 patients into the Master Protocol, 36 since the start of the year.

90 of them have gone on to be registered, 29 since the beginning of the year

In the first three months of Precision-Panc recruiting an average of 2 patients were recruited per month. Over the first three months of 2019 and average of 12 patients were recruited per month – it is fantastic to see how far we have come!



## PRECISION PANC CURRENT NUMBERS

The first PRECISION-PANC site opened on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2017. Since then we have been able to open 19 sites to PRECISION-Panc and enter 125 patients to the platform, of which 90 have proceeded to registration. Open Sites – PRECISION-Panc


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### PRIMUS 001 SPRING UPDATE



# PRECISION PANC SPRING 2019 STUDIES IN SET UP

PRIMUS 004 – This second line, metastatic, umbrella study has recently been endorsed by CRUK. The protocol is in development and the study should open its first appendix (AZD6738 and olaparib) Autumn 2019

PRIMUS 005 (STAR-PAC2) - A phased IIb randomised study repurposing ATRA as a stromal targeting agent in a novel drug combination for pancreatic cancer. This study has agreement in principal funding from the MRC and will open later this year

#### Other Potential Studies / Collaborations

A trial targeting KRAS wild type looking at Erlotinib and Gemcitabine in the metastatic setting is in development

We also hope to work with other studies including MENAC and ACELARATE to help build the Precision-Panc platform and have more options for patients with pancreatic cancer


## PRECISION PANC SPRING 2019 COMPLETED STUDIES

PRIMUS 003 (EVEREST) – A phase Ib and II open label, multi centre study of AZD5069 and durvalumab in patients with metastatic ductal adenocarcinoma.

This trial completed recruitment and the database is now locked. The study samples will be transferred to GPOL for sequencing.
